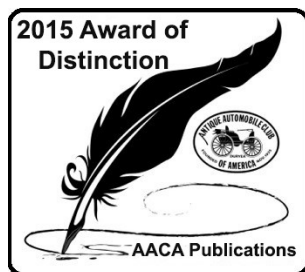

**CLIFF'S ADVENTURES****PONTIAC NATIONALS**

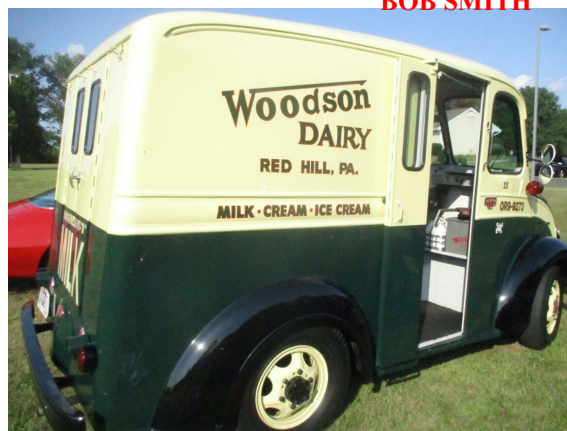

## AACA CAMPAIGN FUND FOR NEW HEADQUARTERS AND LIBRARY



John McCarthy spoke on the funding raising campaign for AACA's new building. AACA's Club Headquarters and Library and Research Center have been housed in the Governor Road building in Hershey for approximately forty years. The building was built in 1920 as a dormitory for students of the Milton Hershey School. The Library was expanded in the 1980's but there is no room for further expansion. Aside from being old and in need of constant repair, the Club and especially the Library are in desperate need for additional room. The Library contains over two million historical auto related books and documents and has been the beneficiary of several large donations of automotive related literature in the past few years.

The new building was built in 1985 for offices and a data center, is 35,000 square feet, is modern and more than twice the size of the existing building. There are 187 parking spaces vs. 13 at Governor Road, and the location is ideal being between the Eastern Fall Meet Show Field and Hershey Park Drive. This building will accommodate AACA's needs for decades to come and provide our Club and the Library with significant exposure being on Hershey Park Drive with many thousand of vehicles passing by each day.

This is the first fund raising campaign that AACA has ever had. The Club and the Library will provide the antique car hobby with a building to serve future generations. John asked those in attendance to consider a donation of \$1,000. John realizes this is a lot of money, but this hobby has given us a great deal and it is AACA that has made it all happen. Some of us have been the beneficiary of a good stock market in recent years and when we consider how much we spend on our antiques cars each year this will donation will provide a means for our hobby to thrive, but any donation would be most appreciated. John mentioned that anyone 70 ½ or older that is required to take a required minimum distribution (RMD) from their IRA can take advantage of the Qualified Charitable Distribution provision whereby such donation is made **directly** from their IRA to AACA, would count toward their RMD, and is not taxable income to them. With the increase in the 2018 standard deduction for a couple to \$24,000 this provides the taxpayer with an additional incentive to use the Qualified Charitable Distribution provision. Anyone that has already made their RMD for 2018 could make this donation from their IRA in 2019. If anyone has any questions John would be happy to assist them at 610-689-0713. Thank you.
